Minutes.

Chairman's address.

Accounts.

The Chair asked members of the public present if they had any questions on the accounts. There were none.

Vandalism & Litter.

Cllr. Mrs. Heal said that a litter picking day was arranged for the 3rd of June and the Clerk asked if he might purchase litter pickers and gloves etc. for this occasion. This was agreed unanimously.

It was generally agreed that there was a lot of litter in the village particularly in the alleyways and on the path to the rec. there was also continued Fly tipping at the bottle bank site. The Chair asked if members of the public would please inform the Clerk of any instances of fly tipping they saw.

Street Lighting.

The Chair invited Cllr. Mrs. Stocking to outline her proposal for rationalisation of the village street lighting.

Cllr. Mrs. Stocking said that she was concerned at the cost to the village of the lighting system and suggested that some of the alleyway lights, which consisted of a third of the total, could be taken out of service when they became in need of replacement.

There was a general discussion on street lighting and opinion was equally divided on the question of retaining all lights or the phasing out of some of the less useful ones.

The Chair suggested that this item be placed on the agenda when a full Council was present.
